1. What does going 100% look like to you?

4. Whether Volleyball for Lexi or relationships for Bailey - both athletes were putting their hope in something that ultimately failed them. What things do you put your hope in and how have they failed you?
5. As an athlete there will be highs and lows throughout your career. Both Lexi and Bailey have found strength to face whatever comes their way as result of their freedom in Christ - Describe a time that you experienced either a high or a low in your sport and how God impacted you in that moment.
6. What stood out to you about how Jim Elliot was living his life?

## **Huddle Session #2**

1. What is so rare today but normal to God in the life and ministry of Jim Elliot?
2. Read 2 Timothy 2:3-7 – What are civilian pursuits that we often get entangled with that prevent us from being an obedient soldier for Christ? – What would be an example of competing according to the rules of the kingdom of man, but breaking the rules of the kingdom of God? – What prevents you from working hard in your pursuit of Christ and the goal He has set out for you to conform to His likeness?
3. Read Romans 8:13 – Based on this verse and looking at your past week - have you been living according to the flesh or by the spirit and what's evidence of that? Do you thirst for the world or the word more? Why???
4. If a teammate finally understood they were living according to the flesh and facing spiritual death, what message of hope would you share with them about Christ?
5. Why do you think Jim Elliot was willing to share in the suffering of Christ? What would it take for you to be willing to share in that same suffering?
6. How can we grow in seeing what we are currently going through as a launchpad in a life of Radical Obedience to Christ.
